

Mr Cezary Falkiewicz is a graduate of the Faculty of Law and Administration at Cardinal Stefan Wyszyński University in Warsaw. He also holds a postgraduate degree in Finance and Accounting with ACCA accreditation from the Vistula University of Finance and Business. He has been involved in state administration since 2014, starting at the Ministry of the Treasury, then being employed at the Chancellery of the Prime Minister and the Ministry of State Assets, where he currently serves as Deputy Director of the Department of Fuel and Energy Companies.

In his work to date, he has mainly dealt with economic and financial analyses of companies and issues relating to the acquisition of shares by the Treasury from the Reprivatisation Fund.
